I use technical chart analysis such as decreased volatility, MACD 'equalization', money flow indicators and others to find best entry points. However, my real strategy is to use pair trading to mitigate the natural volatility of having a concentrated portfolio of 15 stocks, but shorting is not allowed. Please note: there are important restrictions here at Marketocracy that legitimize my fund's performance (e.g. SEC mutual fund guidelines, allocation restrictions (25%), no margin, fund expenses, and real world trade execution system).
